

In the State Of Odisha

Odisha is one of the 29 states of India, located in the eastern coast. It is surrounded by the states of West Bengal to the north-east, Jharkhand to the north, Chhattisgarh to the west and north-west, and Andhra Pradesh to the south and south-west. Odisha has 485 kilometres (301 miles) of coastline along the Bay of Bengal on its east, from Balasore to Malkangiri. It is the 9th largest state by area, and the 11th largest by population. With 32.6 per cent of its population dubbed as poor, Odisha is only behind Bihar so far as poverty headcount ratio (HCR) is concerned, the latest Economic Survey has revealed. The State of Odisha occupies an important place in the country having a high concentration of Scheduled Tribe and Scheduled Caste population & OBC & other poor are followed by them. The poverty factor created in this state by some important factors & first of all a natural calamity of every year pushes this state towards back & another factor is lack of proper education & awareness among the people.

Navjivan for more than 5 years working in different areas of the three districts i.e. Balasore, Bhadrakh & Jajpur & organization has arranged some important camps in this location district in most rural areas from food, clothing, medical, and education, animal & birds, agriculture, counseling, child development, education, energy, environment, helping hand, legal, medical, natural disaster, peace & security, science & technology, social, senior citizen, suggestion, woman's development, youth development, research, handicraft etc.

Population of Orissa in 2015 is 44,338,419 (44.3 million). Population in the state has been growing on a descent growth rate of 1.4% every year. Sex Ratio of Orissa is 972 females per 1000 males in 2001 census. Orissa Literacy rate has improved by 10% in this decade. Orissa with 169 per sq. km. density of Population is below the national average of 382 per sq. km.

Balasore rural Works Division, Balasore covers the whole territorial jurisdiction of Balasore District. It consists of 4 Assembly Constituencies in full namely Balasore, Basta, Remuna, Nilgiri. The jurisdiction of this Division covers 6 blocks namely Balasore, Basta, Banarpal, Baliap (Part) Remuna, Nilgiri, Oupada consisting of 115 Gram Panchyats.

Bhadrakh rural works division-II, Bhadrak covers part territorials of Bhadrak District. It consists of 5 Assembly constituency namely Bhadrak, Basudevpur, Chandbali, Dhamnagar, Chandaripokhari. The jurisdiction of this division covers 5 Blocks namely Bhadrak, Basudevpur, Chandbali, Dhamnagar, Chandaripokhari.

Jajpur rural has got one sub division namely Jajpur. There are 10 Tahsils, 10 Blocks, 280 G.Ps, 1781 Villages and 18 Police stations functioning in the District.



Odisha has an agriculture based economy which is in transition towards an industrial and service-based economy. The primary industries in Odisha are manufacturing; mining and quarrying; electricity, gas and water supply and construction. The Rural Development Department deal with Minor Irrigation, Lift Irrigation, Rural Road, Rural Water Supply and Sanitation sectors.

In the state with its high rain fall distributed over a four month monsoon and reasonably moderate winter allows for growing a variety of Horticultural crops. The normal rainfall received from June to September from South-West monsoon is immensely suitable for growing Perennial fruit crops like mango, litchi, guava, oranges and limes : annual fruit crops like banana, pineapple and papaya, spices like ginger, turmeric and chilly, a variety of root and tubers and a whole range of vegetables. The low temperature existing in hilly areas at higher altitude offer ideal conditions for growing off-season vegetables. The state thus enjoys a natural comparative advantage for Horticulture with possibilities for growing a diversified basket of fruits, vegetables, spices, tuber crops and flowers whose potential has not been fully exploited. Perennial Horticulture crops also help the farmer to secure against unforeseen droughts. Preferably existing high land of our state is most suitable for cultivation of perennial fruit crops.

Awareness

In India awareness is necessary because lack of education & poverty is restricting rural people from fine progress. Awareness is the state or ability to perceive, to feel, or to be conscious of events, objects or sensory patterns. In this level of consciousness, an observer can confirm sense data without necessarily implying understanding. More broadly, it is the state or quality of being aware of something. In biological psychology, awareness is defined as a human's or an animal's perception and cognitive reaction to a condition or event. We have several awareness brochures. Awareness on Road Safety Knowledge on road safety need for all kind of people, especially it is necessary for the youth mass. So we have arranged awareness in Odisha for some days continuing because road safety is an important education for people of all ages. In order to observe & follow the rules of the road, one must be educated on what, when and why they work. From crossing the road, to cycling to driving a four wheeler everyone should know the rules of the road. The rules are created keeping the uniformity of people in mind so that each person can follow the same set of rules to help one another to drive safely from cyclists, car drivers, pedestrians and so on without any discordance.

Our organization has divided our awareness programme in three ways like as social, medical and legal awareness and on social consciousness is consciousness shared within a society. It can also be defined as social awareness; to be aware of the problems that different societies and communities face on a day-to-day basis; to be conscious of the difficulties and hardships of a society. There is debate as to exactly what the term means. Some people define social consciousness as a society's consciousness of itself.

Social consciousness brings moral implications. Often, people with an awakened social consciousness become socially active. A socially conscious person tends to be empathetic towards others regardless of race, gender, ethnicity, disability, class, or sexual identity. We include Education, Pollution, India's Oil & Agriculture, Water Harvesting, Women Empowerment Etc.

On our Medical Awareness we say that our body is the gift and it's donated by nature and we have to keep safe from disease. Because diseases free body give good health and healthy mind for better work and good thinking. So basic awareness is needed for every human being about the diseases and the preliminary treatment of health. Animals & Birds

The forests of India are ancient in nature and composition. Indian people need to have more wildlife education. They are rich in variety and shelter a wide range of flora and fauna and insects. The fact they have existed from time immemorial is substantiated from the ancient texts all of which have some mention of the forests. The people venerated forests and a large number of religious ceremonies centered on trees and plants. Even today in parts of India the sacred forests exist and are worshiped.

The wildlife in India is equally diverse and rich. From big animals like elephants and tiger and deers and bisons to small reptiles the Indian forests are teeming with life force. But unfortunately most Indians don't understand the importance of this rich wealth of forest and wildlife India has. Felling of trees and illegal poaching of animals are fast depleting the forest and wildlife wealth of India. So efforts must be taken to stop these malpractices and conserve the forest and wildlife of India.

India has unmatched variety of flora and fauna that makes it extensively different from the rest of the world. Tourists visiting for wildlife tour in India will enjoy during any season, but to experience migrating birds, tiger, leopard, barasingha and other rare species, then winter is the best season to visit sanctuaries especially for those tourists coming for wildlife tour in India.

Due to water scarcity in the hot weather, animals and birds come out in herds in search of water, therefore most of the sanctuaries are closed during summer season. Tourists cannot go for jungle safari in an open jeep but the experience on elephants back is overwhelming. Wildlife Conservation Society(WCS) India in association with other NGO partners and tribal people, is making every possible effort to develop new models of wildlife conservation to preserve India's most treasured fauna and to protect the environment.

Like other natural resource and life God has given animals and birds for the same rights in the earth but at present time the people kill them for food and some for the global warming. Many species have not seen at present.

So our awareness to solve this problem was satisfactory and by counseling some forest area people we have tried to save animals and birds life on the way of animals and birds love. We are working with Navjivan Foundation on these activities since 2009 & it always on the process.



Agriculture

Organizations give importance to development of Indian agriculture by giving proper awareness in modern technology using & the standard as India's population is growing faster than its ability to produce food grains. The required level of investment for the development of marketing, storage and cold storage infrastructure is estimated to be huge. In India agriculture depends upon the monsoon rainfall is the most important of the climatic factors. The areas of very heavy rainfall exist on the windward side of the Western Ghats, the Khasi Hills & the Himalayas. These are the source regions for many of the major river systems of the country, particularly the Himalayan ranges. India is a land of many climates and varieties of soils affording scope for much diversity in agriculture. The geographic location and the physical features largely determine the climate of the country. The pattern of rainfall all over India reflects the climatic variations in the different parts of the country.

Today, India ranks second in the world in farm output. Agriculture and allied activities like forestry, plantation, horticulture etc. account for approximately, provides employment to over a maximum percentage of the total workforce and is the largest economic sector which plays a significant role in the overall socio-economic development of India. Our country is the largest producer in the world of milk, cashew nuts, coconuts, tea, ginger, turmeric and black pepper. It also has the world's largest cattle population. It is the second largest producer of wheat, rice, sugar, groundnut and inland fish. It is the third largest producer of tobacco.

Slow agricultural growth is a concern for policymakers as some two-thirds of India's people depend on rural employment for a living. Current agricultural practices are neither economically nor environmentally sustainable and India's yields for many agricultural commodities are low. Poor maintained irrigation systems and almost universal lack of good extension services are among the factors responsible. Farmers' access to markets is hampered by poor roads, inadequate marketing infrastructure, and excessive regulation. Illiteracy, general socio-economic backwardness, slow progress in implementing land reforms and inadequate or inefficient finance and marketing services for farm produce.

The average size of land holdings is very small and is subject to fragmentation, due to land ceiling acts and in some cases, family disputes. Such small holdings are often over-manned resulting in disguised unemployment and low productivity of labor. Adoption of modern agricultural practices and use of technology is inadequate, hampered by ignorance of such practices, high costs and impracticality in the case of small land holdings. Irrigation facilities are inadequate which result in farmers still being dependent on rainfall, specifically the Monsoon season. A good monsoon results in robust growth for the economy as a whole, while a poor monsoon leads to a sluggish growth. Following are the some other issues those need to be promptly addressed.



Counseling


Organization Counseling is the activity of the counselor, or a professional who counsels people (gives them assistance, advice and guidance, especially on personal problems and difficulties. We try to solve the problem by counseling because now a day's core cases under court fear police which is unsolved. So it is the best process of to solve the matter.

Organization Counseling is a process in which the relationship formed between we and our counselor help party develop more awareness and understanding of ourselves. Any process takes time initially, much of the counselor's time is used to understand our story and look at things from person's perspective.

Throughout the counseling process, the counselor tries to avoid giving suggestions or advice. Instead, our counselor's job is to act like a mirror and reflect back to its behavior, thoughts and feelings in a way that helps for understand them more clearly and sometimes from a different perspective. What others choose to do with this understanding is completely left up to people. The counselor provides with a safe environment to open up and explore public without the fear of being judged.

In many ways, this gradual process produces longer lasting results than any advice or solution giving because it learn to look at party problems from a different perspective and learn the skills to solve them on people own. Such learning comes in handy while dealing with your past, present or future problems. Our professional counselor duties listed are those for which Counselors are assessed and compensated. Department assignments may be more specific. These professional duties will be performed under the supervision of Management.

Each of us can be faced with life events that are difficult to manage. Relationship problems, work-related issues, parenting challenges, depression, grief, aging parent concerns, alcohol or drug use problems, and chronic health difficulties are just a few examples of common challenges that can diminish our abilities to effectively manage our activities from one day to the next. Every person has his or her own method of determining when it would be useful to seek outside help. The statements listed below are frequently used to determine whether there is a need for outside help. If these statements ring true for you, our services may be helpful. We at our level try to solve the problem if tried for several times & at last if not possible send all the matter to the concern department or courts as the case may be.



Child Development

In our system of Child Development we focus generally on the Child Development which refers to the biological and psychological changes that occur in human beings between birth and the end of adolescence, as the individual progresses from dependency to increasing autonomy. Because these developmental changes may be strongly influenced by genetic factors and events during prenatal life, genetics and prenatal development are usually included as part of the study of child development. Related terms include developmental psychology, referring to development throughout the lifespan, and pediatrics, the branch of medicine relating to the care of children. Developmental change may occur as a result of genetically-controlled processes known as maturation, or as a result of environmental factors and learning, but most commonly involves an interaction between the two. There are various definitions of periods in child development, since each period is a continuum with individual differences regarding start and ending.

We give importance on some age-related development periods and examples of defined intervals are: newborn (ages 0–1 month); infant (ages 1 month – 1 year); toddler (ages 1–3 years); preschooler (ages 4–6 years); school-aged child (ages 6–13 years); adolescent (ages 13–20). The optimal development of children is considered vital to society and so it is important to understand the social, cognitive, emotional, and educational development of children. Increased research and interest in this field has resulted in new theories and strategies, with specific regard to practice that promotes development within the school system. In addition there are also some theories that seek to describe a sequence of states that comprise child development.

India has around 150 million or more and more children, who are below the age of 14 years. A large number of them live in economic and social environment, which impede the child's physical and mental development. These conditions include poverty, poor environmental sanitation, disease, infection, inadequate access to primary health care; inappropriate child caring and feeding practices. Our Govt. has several policy on child development.

Navjivan Foundation focuses in this topic from its beginning. The organization work on different topic of child development like Child Labor & Abuse, Child welfare, child death, Child education and at present our institution help to give elementary education to the orphan or street children and our future motto to establish a orphan home with proper medical facility and recreation center.

Through the awareness camp we advice to the parents how to protect the children & what type of behavior should be for the different type of environment & in the school we with love advice to the children how they should behave to their elders etc.



Education



Women's education in India has also been a major preoccupation of both the government and civil society as educated women can play a very important role in the development of the country. Although in the Vedic period women had access to education in India, they had gradually lost the right. However, in the British period there was revival of interest in women's education in India.

Women's education in India plays a very important role in the overall development of the country. It not only helps in the development of half of the human resources, but also improving the quality of life at home and outside. Educated women not only tend to promote education of their girl children, but also can provide better guidance to all their children. Moreover, educated women can also help in the reduction of infant mortality rate and growth of the population. Gender discrimination still persists in India and lot more needs to be done in the field of women's education in India. The gap in the male-female literacy rate is just a simple indicator.

Providing access to basic education is a duty the Indian state that has taken upon itself. Thus the differently able children are provided special education in India so that they can seriously engage in improving the quality of their life. With the advancement of technology, Special education in India for physically disabled or mentally challenged is also fast improving.

But some recent research has thrown fresh insights on Special education in India was present since the pre independence time, with very few schools or NGOs helping intellectually impaired children. However over the years many scholars have questioned the importance of special education in India as they feel that it leads to segregation and isolation of the differently baled children.



Energy

On our work for the save energy we focus/awareness on renewable energy & this energy generated from natural resources such as sunlight, wind, rain, tides, and geothermal heat, which are renewable (naturally replenished). While most renewable energy projects and production is large scale, renewable technologies are also suited to small off-grid applications, sometimes in rural and remote areas, where energy is often crucial in human development.


Some renewable energy technologies are criticized for being intermittent or unsightly, yet the renewable energy market continues to grow. Climate change concerns, coupled with high oil prices, peak oil, and increasing government support, are driving increasing renewable energy legislation, incentives and commercialization. New government spending, regulation and policies helped the industry weather the 2009 economic crisis better than many other sectors.

On the electricity energy high technical losses in the system are primarily due to inadequate investments over the years for system improvement works, which has resulted in unplanned extensions of the distribution lines, overloading of the system elements like transformers and conductors, and lack of adequate reactive power support. The commercial losses are mainly due to low metering efficiency, theft & pilferages. This may be eliminated by improving metering efficiency, proper energy accounting & auditing and improved billing & collection efficiency.

Save energy refers to reducing energy consumption through using less of an energy service. Energy conservation differs from efficient energy use, which refers to using less energy for a constant service. Driving less is an example of energy conservation. Driving the same amount with a higher mileage vehicle is an example of energy efficiency. Energy conservation and efficiency are both energy reduction techniques. Energy conservation is sometimes known as sufficiency.

Even though energy conservation reduces energy services, it can result in increased environmental quality, national security, personal financial security & higher savings. It is at the top of the sustainable energy hierarchy. It also lowers energy costs by preventing future resources depletion.

So under our awareness we invite people to avoid adding to the power demand during the peak time. By simply using some of our common electrical appliances before and after this time band washing machines, geysers, irons, building water pumps – all can be shifted without much inconvenience. Whenever we leave a plug point 'ON' after switching an electrical appliance 'OFF' with the remote, power is still being consumed in 'stand-by mode'. And no small amount either these little wastages account for an unbelievable 5% of the city's power consumption. In ACs possibly the biggest cause of any summer power crisis. Every time one more AC is switched on and every time the temperature is lowered by one more degree, a huge load is added to the system.



Environment


The natural environment is contrasted with the built environment which comprises the areas and components that are strongly influenced by humans. The concept of the natural environment can be distinguished by components: Complete ecological units that function as natural systems without massive human intervention, including all vegetation, animal, microorganisms, soil, rocks, atmosphere and natural phenomena that occur within their boundaries; universal natural resources and physical phenomena that lack clear-cut boundaries, such as air, water and climate, as well as energy, radiation, electric charge, and magnetism, not originating from human activity. These all are free gift of nature & we should enjoy that but not to disturb that although present time we disturb it's by way of Air Pollution, Water Pollution, Soil pollution & Noise pollution. Several Camps in different areas we have arranged since 2003 to present on save clemency we arrange several plantation in this matter.

Air pollution is the introduction of chemicals, particulate matter, or biological materials that cause harm or discomfort to humans or other living organisms, or damages the natural environment, into the atmosphere. The atmosphere is a complex, dynamic natural gaseous system that is essential to support life on planet Earth. Stratospheric ozone depletion due to air pollution has long been recognized as a threat to human health as well as to the Earth's ecosystems in our country it has no limitation.

Water pollution is the contamination of water bodies such as lakes, rivers, oceans, lagoons, and groundwater. All water pollution affects organisms and plants that live in these bodies of water and in almost all cases the effect is damaging either to individual species and populations but also to the natural biological. It occurs when pollutants are discharged directly or indirectly into water bodies without adequate treatment to remove harmful constituents.

Soil pollution is caused by the presence of man-made chemicals or other alteration in the natural soil environment. This type of contamination typically arises from the rupture of underground application of pesticides, percolation of contaminated surface water to subsurface strata, oil and fuel dumping, leaching of wastes from landfills or direct discharge of industrial wastes to the soil. The most common chemicals involved are petroleum hydrocarbons, solvents, pesticides, lead and other heavy metals. This occurrence of this phenomenon is correlated with the degree of industrialization and intensities of chemical usage.

Noise pollution is displeasing human-, animal- or machine-created sound that disrupts the activity or balance of human or animal life. The word noise comes from the Latin word nausea meaning seasickness. The source of most outdoor noise worldwide is transportation systems, including motor vehicle noise, aircraft and rail noise. Poor urban planning may give rise to noise pollution, since side-by-side industrial and residential buildings can result in noise pollution in the residential area. 
Helping Hand

Thus, disability is a complex phenomenon, reflecting an interaction between features of a person's body and features of the society in which he or she lives. Disability is a contested concept, with different meanings for different communities. On the one hand, it may be used to refer to physical or mental attributes that some institutions, particularly medicine, view as needing to be fixed the medical model .it may refer to limitations on participation in social life imposed on people by the constraints of an ablest society. The medical model, or the term may serve to name a social identity claimed by people with disabilities in order to mark their shared goals and politics.

Enhancing employment opportunities for people with disabilities our effort is one of the main concerns of the disability sector in India. When one looks at the micro level, it may seem like there has been progress. There is increased awareness amongst Corporate and people with disabilities. There is a wide gap between the employment rate of people with and without disabilities in the country.

Therefore, the above target for bringing down the unemployment rate cannot be achieved without addressing the employment issues of people with disabilities, who constitute about 6% of the population. It would require proactive initiative on the part of all concerned to ensure that disability is included in the employment programmes of ours.

In civil law systems, contract and tort fall under general law of obligations, while trusts law is dealt with under statutory regimes or international conventions.

During the drafting of the Indian constitution, Indian laws also adhere to the United Nations guidelines on human rights law and the environmental law. Certain international tread laws, such as those on intellectual property, are also enforced in India.

Indian personal law is fairly complex, with each religion adhering to its own specific law. In most states, registering of marriages and divorces is not compulsory. Separate laws govern Hindus, Muslims, Christians and followers of other religions. The exception to this rule is in the state of Goa where a uniform civil code is in place, in which all religions have a common law regarding marriage, divorces, and adoption.





The British system of education, in its efforts to give rise to a native class of civil servants, exposed a number of Indians to foreign institutes of higher learning. Following independence science and technology in the Republic of India has included automobile engineering, information technology, communications as well as space, polar, and nuclear. Science and technology, however, is used as an effective instrument for growth and change. It is being brought into the mainstream of economic planning in the sectors of agriculture, industry and services. The country's resources are used to derive the maximum output for the benefit of society and improvement in the quality of life. About 85 per cent of the funds for S&T come directly or indirectly from the Government. The S&T infrastructure in the country accounts for more than one per cent of the GNP. A society, however, may be ontologically independent of, and utterly irreducible to, the qualities of constituent individuals; it may act to oppression. The urbanization and rationalization inherent in some, particularly Western capitalist, societies, has been associated with feelings of isolation and social anomie. More broadly, a society is an economic, social or industrial infrastructure made up of a varied collection of individuals. Members of a society may be from different ethnic groups. A society may be a particular ethnic group, such as the Saxons; a nation state, such as Bhutan; a broader cultural group, such as a Western society.

The word society may also refer to an organized voluntary association of people for religious, benevolent, cultural, scientific, political, patriotic, or other purposes. A society may even though more by means of metaphor refer to a social organism such as an ant colony. So the people living in the society are social nature and if any one try to be unsocial will punishable by the local rule. Because for the safety of society some general rules are made. In the absence of agreement about its meaning, the term social is used in many different senses and regarded as a fuzzy concept referring among other things to: attitude, orientations, or behaviors which take the interests, intentions, or needs of other people into account (in contrast to anti-social behavior); has played some role in defining the idea or the principle. There is few rules of the society and conduct by Social justice, so it is the application of the concept of justice on a social scale. Social justice is a concept that some use to describe the movement towards a socially just world. In this context, social justice is based on the concepts of human rights and equality and involves a greater degree of economic egalitarianism through progressive taxation, income redistribution, or even property redistribution. Policies aimed toward achieving that which developmental economists refer to as more equality of opportunity and equality of outcome than may currently exist in some societies or are available to some classes in a given society. From the above discussion and for short and easiest method for the Social Navjivan Foundation finds the term except medical and legal work all the work go to social nature. So organization classified its all the work for simple understanding of the general people in social, medical and legal way.

It is the leading cause of disability in people over the age of 55. There are different types of arthritis that cause varied levels of discomfort. Treatment options include physical therapy, occupational therapy and medication as well as procedures such as an Arthroplasty or joint replacement surgery. A balanced diet, body cleansing, physical activity, sweating and relaxation techniques may be used make patients feel better.

Osteoporosis is a silent disease in which bones become extremely fragile. If left untreated, it can progress painlessly until a bone breaks. These broken bones, also known as fractures, typically occur in the hip, spine and wrist. They are extremely painful and can take a long time to heal. So for general treatment to keep fit to senior citizen is Take recommended amounts of calcium and vitamin D daily. Participate in regular weight-bearing exercise. Avoid smoking and excessive alcohol. Take a bone density test to check the condition of bones.

Developing new features and making changes takes time. If a suggestion has not been implemented, this does not necessarily mean it has been rejected. Developers must assign time to a variety of projects, and some features may take longer to develop than initially guessed. While a suggestion with a lot of positive feedback is more likely to be considered than one that is mostly disagreed with, the final decision to implement or not implement any given suggestion is in the hands of management and the developers.

To be useful to the family, community and the society, women must be provided with health care facilities.

Most of the women work in agricultural sector either as workers, in household farms or as day-labourers. Yet it is precisely livelihood in agriculture that has tended to become more volatile and insecure in recent years and women cultivators have therefore been negatively affected. The government's policies for alleviating poverty have failed to produce any desirable results, as women do not receive appropriate wages for their labor.

There is also significant amount of unpaid or non-marketed labor within the household. The increase in gender disparity in wages in the urban areas is also quite marked as a result from the employment of women in different and lower paying activities. They are exploited at various levels. They should be provided with proper wages and work at par with men so that their status can be elevated in society.



Equality between men and women is more than a matter of social justice - it's a fundamental human right. But gender equality also makes good economic sense. When women have equal access to education, and go on to participate fully in business and economic decision-making, they are a key driving force against poverty. Women with equal rights are better educated, healthier and have greater access to land, jobs and financial resources. Their increased earning power in turn raises household incomes. By enhancing women's control over decision-making in the household, gender equality also translates into better prospects and greater well-being of children, reducing poverty of future generations.
